### THE VENUE

The workshop will be held at the Lodge on the Loch, an exquisite venue on the banks of Loch Lomond, Scotland. The Hotel and venue is a premium location which is easily accessed from Glasgow International Airport (30 minutes taxi ride) or Glasgow City Centre (45 minute taxi ride).

### TRANSPORT

We can assist with transport to and from the airport – delegates would need to arrange this with the hotel when they book. A transfer from airport is approx £50 - £60, paid in cash at end of journey. It can be added to your room bill, but will then become subject to VAT (17.5%) plus a small administration fee.
